All vessels kept, used or navigated in the Broads Authority's Navigation Area for more than 28 days in any year must be registered with the Broads Authority and pay the Annual Toll. Vessels remaining in the Navigation Area for 28 days or less in a year need not be registered, but must pay a Short Visit Toll.

The Tolls year runs from 1 April to 31 March the following year.

Tolls plaques issued on any date after 1 April will expire on 31 March following.

There is no reduction in price for this.

**Note 1:** 'Overall length' means the full length of a vessel and includes any fixed fendering, bowsprit and such davits as are not retractable attached to the vessel.

**Note 2:** 'Hull length' means the hull length of a vessel including any fixed fendering but excluding any bowsprit or davits attached to the vessel.

**Note 3:** 'Extreme beam' means the full width of a vessel at its widest part and includes fixed fendering.

**Note 4:** A 'day hire boat' is defined as a boat without any berths (sleeping accommodation), toilet or cooker.
