Adoption Statement 25 November 2011**

In accordance with Regulations 24 and 36 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004 (as amended 2008), notice is hereby given that on 18 November 2011, the Broads Authority formally resolved to adopt the Broads Authority Development Management Policies Development Plan Document (DPD). This DPD forms part of the Local Development Framework for the Broads Authority. It contains policies covering the period 2011-2021 and replaces relevant parts of the Broads Local Plan (adopted 1997).

The Development Management Policies DPD was considered by an independent Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State, as part of a Public Examination, with hearings held on 12 and 13 July 2011. The Inspector's report was published on 17 October 2011 and concluded that the DPD was 'sound', subject to a number of required changes. The adopted DPD incorporates the binding recommendations of the Inspector.

Any person aggrieved by the Adoption of the Broads Authority Development Management Policies DPD may make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004, on the grounds that the document is not within the appropriate powers of the Broads Authority and/or procedural requirements have not been complied with. Any such application must be made promptly and no later than 6 weeks after the date on which the Broads Authority Development Management Policies DPD was adopted, i.e. by 6 January 2012.
