

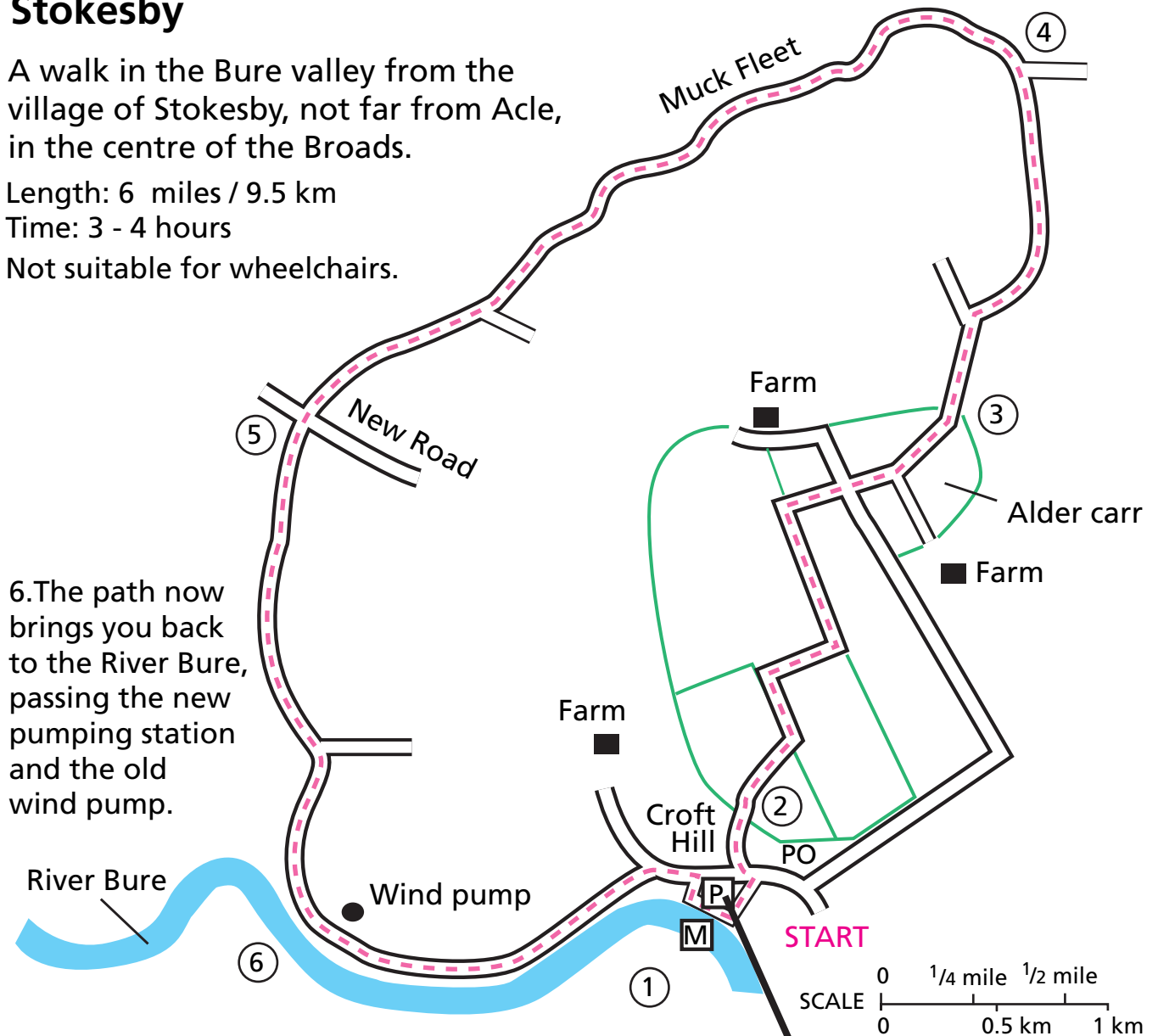
Stokesby

A walk in the Bure valley from the village of Stokesby, not far from Acle, in the centre of the Broads.

Length: 6 miles / 9.5 km

Time: 3 - 4 hours

Not suitable for wheelchairs.



6. The path now brings you back to the River Bure, passing the new pumping station and the old wind pump.

5. After crossing New Road, the path winds and tunnels through old hedgerows of hawthorn, sycamore and elder. Look for wild flowers here in the spring.

4. This stretch of the walk takes you on part of the Muck Fleet, the main draining dyke for the surrounding marshes. Look out for birds in the reed and sedge.

3. You now enter an area of carr woodland. The mixture of trees and shrubs is good for wildlife.

2. You now pass through three fields. Cut straight across the first field and follow the paths around the other two.

1. Car parking and moorings are at Stokesby staithe. From here head towards the pub and turn left up Ferry Lane. Turn left at the top, then first right up Croft Hill, and out of the village.
