<b>Description/Context:</b> - White painted tower mill, 4 storeys with glazed 'look-out' on top and half barrel-shaped black timber roof. Some original window openings with plain glazing Large black timber and pantile building attached. Converted to residential use			
<b>Significance:</b> - Although considerable alterations have been carried in connection with the residential conversion, the mill tower is largely intact and is one of a significant group of drainage mills in the Broads area and a prominent feature in the landscape.
