TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING GENERAL DEVELOPMENT ORDER 1973

DIRECTION RESTRICTING PERMITTED DEVELOPMENT

WHEREAS the Council of the County of Norfolk being the Local Planning Authority for the Rural District of Smallburgh are satisfied that it is expedient that development of the description set out in the Schedule hereto should not be carried out on the piece of land shown hatched black on the plan annexed hereto situate in the Parish of Hoveton in the Rural District of Smallburgh in the County of Norfolk unless permission therefore is granted on an application in that behalf.

NOW THEREFORE the said Council in persuance of the powers conferred upon them by Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1973, HEREBY DIRECT that the permission granted by Article 3 of the said Order shall not apply to development on the said land of the descriptions set out in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

The use on not more than 14 days in total in any calendar year of land for the purposes of ~~retail sale and car parking incidental thereto~~ the holding of markets.

Being development comprised in paragraph 2 of Class iv of the first Schedule to the said Order and not being development comprised within any other class.
