<b>Description/Context:</b> - Remains of trestle mill – 4 red brick support piers averaging 4' in height. AC Smith records an iron wheel on spindle to concrete pump shaft; this was not apparent at time of inspection, although site much overgrown. (AC Smith notes that this mill would have been similar to Boardman's Mill at How Hill).			
<b>Significance:</b> - The site of one of an important group of drainage mills in the Broads area and a feature in the landscape.			
<b>Threat posed:</b> - Vegetation over growth, removal of relatively small fragments.
