

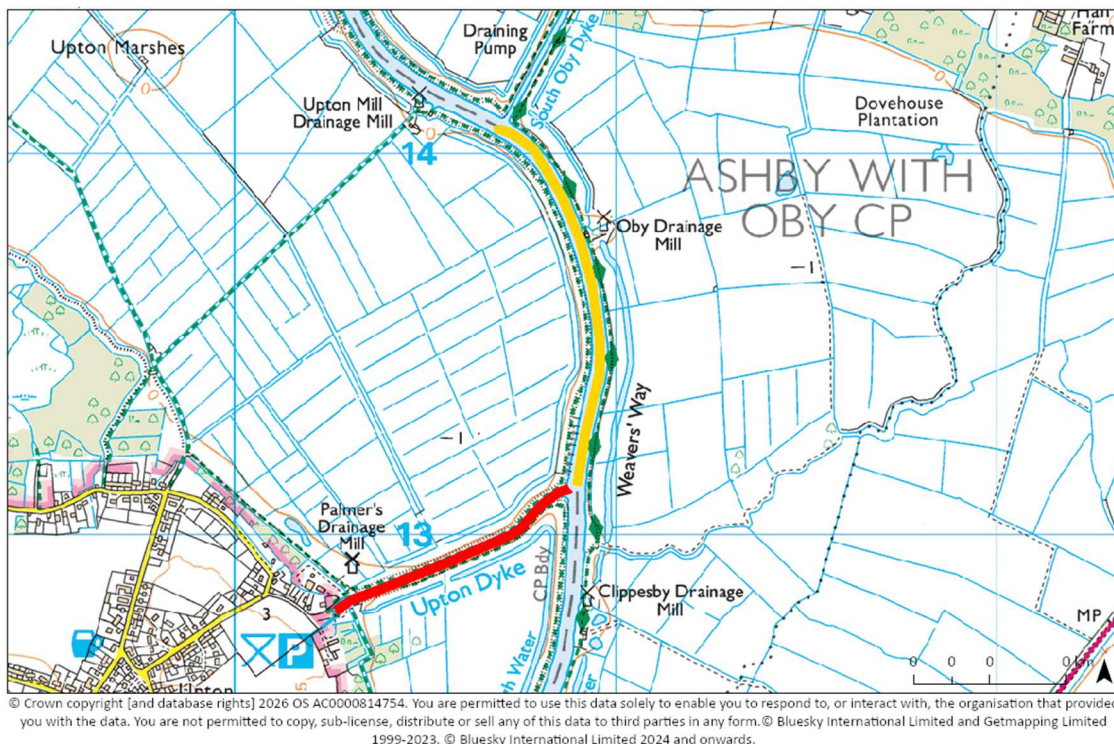
Update - Navigation Restrictions due to Dredging Works on the River Bure

Additional dredging required to address a reported shallow area upstream of Upton Dyke to be undertaken. Dates for dredging works now extended to include from Monday 29th June 2026 through to Friday 3rd July 2026.

Notice is hereby given that the Broads Authority will be undertaking dredging works, from **Monday 20th April 2026 through to Friday 8th May 2026** during the hours of 08:00 hours and 16:00 hours daily, excluding weekends. The dredge site stretches along Upton Dyke (TG 40266 12806) (shown in red on the plan extract). The works vessels will be navigating the main river channel to travel along the re-use site, which is located near to Oby Dyke (TG 40874 14397, shown in yellow).

The dredging works will involve the use of large works vessels operating in the area.

Note: During the dredging works, navigation will **remain open**, but vessels must exercise great care whilst proceeding past the vicinity of the works. There may be short periods of time when Upton Dyke will be temporarily blocked, please follow the instructions by the staff on site who will inform you when you can pass safely. Please ensure that the works are taken into consideration for passage planning and when navigating in this area.



All equipment will be lit and signage will be in place to warn of restriction and delays.
