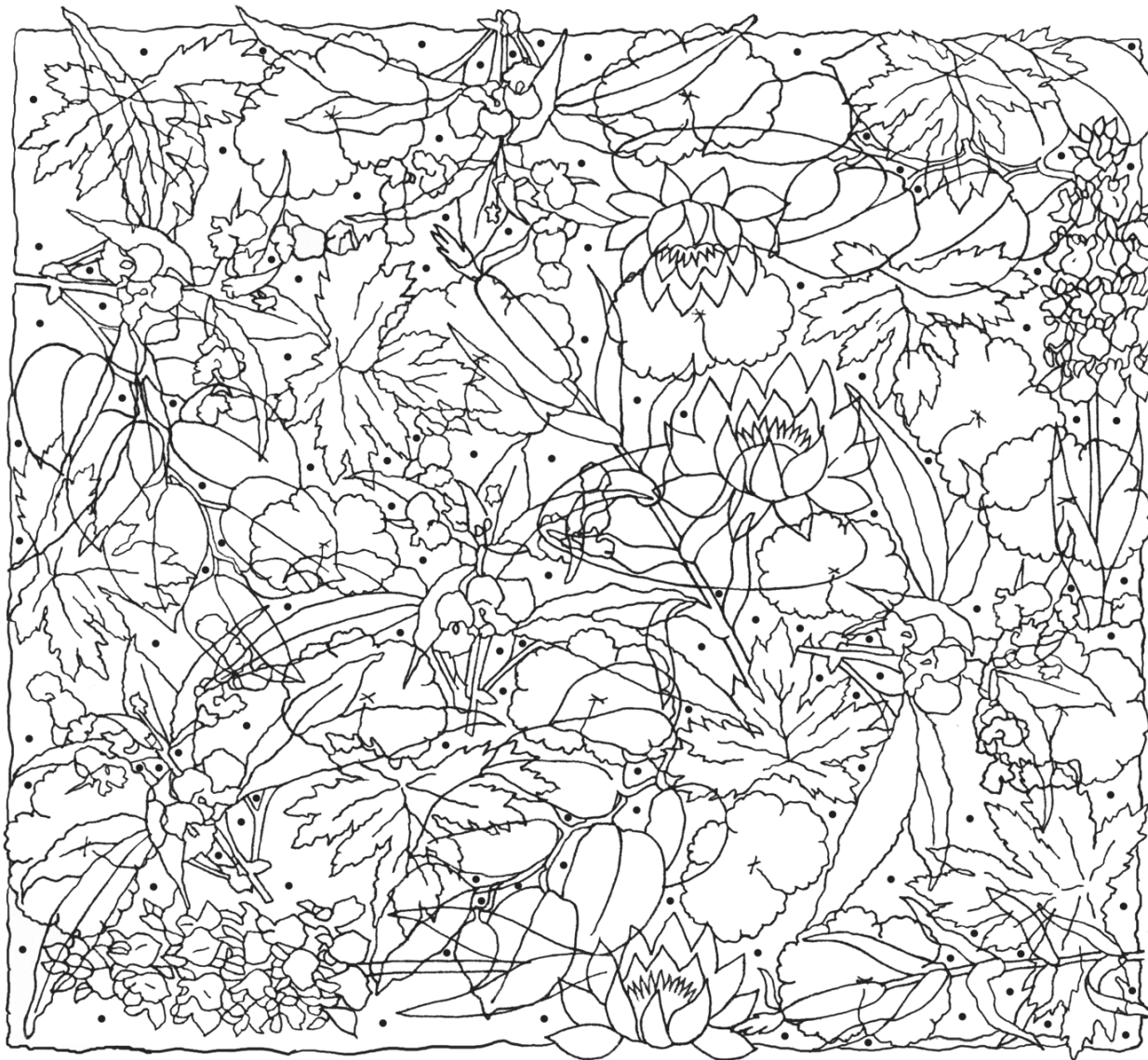


JUMBLE COLOURING PUZZLE

Invasive, non-native plants are a threat to the Broads waterways. They can stop native plants such as white water lilies from growing by crowding them out.

Some species can also choke waterways so they can't be used for boating or fishing and can even increase the risk of flooding.

Some non-native plants arrived here as plants for garden ponds, but then made their way into the wild.
