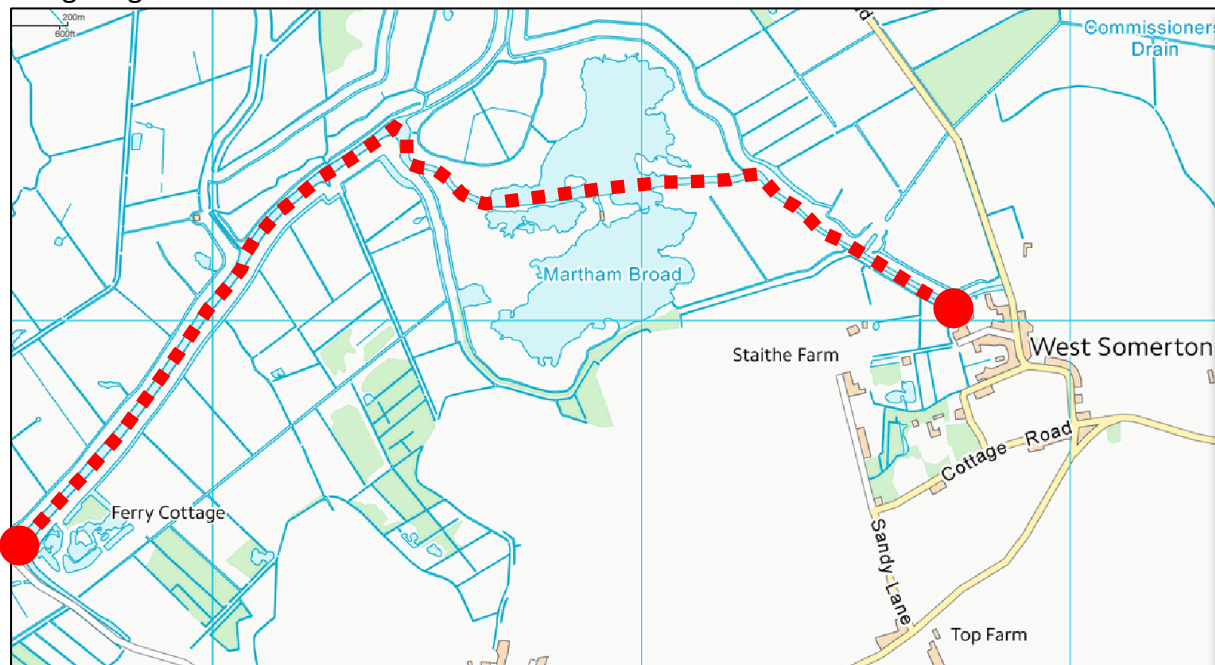


Navigation restriction due to dredging works on the Upper Thurne

Notice is hereby given that the Broads Authority will be undertaking dredging works **from 18 October until 31 December 2021**. The site stretches along the upstream end of the River Thurne, **from** Martham Ferry grid ref TG445194 to West Somerton Staithe grid ref TG467200 (shown in red on the plan extract).

The maintenance works on the water will involve the use of floating pontoons and small works vessels. **Note** during the above period navigation will remain open, but vessels must exercise great care whilst proceeding past the vicinity of the works.

Please ensure that the area is taken into consideration for passage planning and when navigating in this area.
