

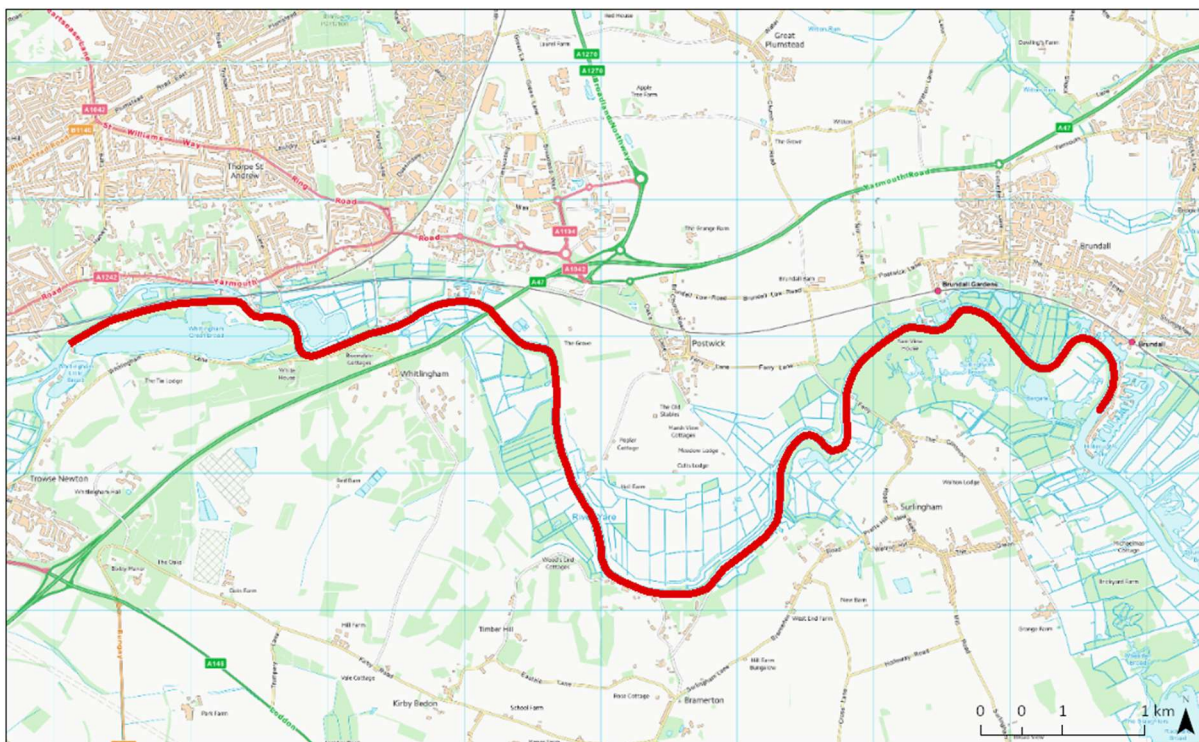
Update - Navigation Restrictions due to Dredging Works on the Upper Yare

Additional dredging required on the Upper Yare River to be undertaken. Dates for dredging works now extended to include from Monday 13th July 2026 through to Friday 21st August 2026.

Notice is hereby given that the Broads Authority will be undertaking dredging works, from **Tuesday 7 April 2026 through to Friday 10th July 2026** during the hours of 08:00 hours and 16:00 hours daily, excluding weekends. The dredge site stretches from Trowse Swing Bridge (TG245076) downstream to Brundall (TG327076) (shown in red on the plan extract). The works vessels will be navigating the main river channel to travel along the dredge site.

The dredging works will involve the use of large works vessels operating in the area.

Note: During the dredging works, navigation will **remain open**, but vessels must exercise great care whilst proceeding past the vicinity of the works. Please ensure that the works are taken into consideration for passage planning and when navigating in this area.



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All equipment will be lit and signage will be in place to warn of restriction and delays.
