

Register of Interests form

As a member of the Broads Authority, these are the interests which you are required to register with the Authority by section 30 of the <u>Localism Act 2011</u>.

Register of interests must be declared:

- within 28 days of becoming a member; and
- within 28 days of becoming aware of any new interest, or of any change to a registered interest.

Failure to register or disclose a disclosable pecuniary interest is a criminal offence under the Localism Act 2011.

Where you have a 'sensitive interest' you must notify the Monitoring Officer with the reasons why you believe it is a sensitive interest. If the Monitoring Officer agrees, they will withhold the interest from the public register. A 'sensitive interest' is an interest which, if disclosed, could lead to the member, or a person connected with the member, being subject to violence or intimidation.

'Disclosable Pecuniary Interest' means an interest of yourself or of your partner if you are aware of your partner's interest.

'Partner' means a spouse or civil partner, or a person with whom you are living as husband or wife, or a person with whom you are living as if you are civil partners.
