

Navigation Restrictions due to dredging works on the Upper Yare, Norwich.

*Note: Due to unavoidable delays in the programme, dredging on the Upper Yare will now continue until **Friday 29th August 2025**.*


Notice is hereby given that the Broads Authority will be undertaking dredging works, from 19th May 2025 through to 29th August 2025, during the hours of 0800 hours and 1600 hours daily, excluding weekends. The dredge site stretches along the Upper Yare from Postwick Viaduct (Grid Reference - TG 28185 08203) to Trowse Swing Bridge (Grid Reference- TG 24549 07629) (shown in **red** on the plan extract). The works vessels will be navigating the main river to travel between the dredge site and the offload site. (shown in **blue** on the plan extract).

The maintenance works on the water will involve the use of floating pontoons and small works vessels.

Note: During the dredging works, navigation will **remain open**, but vessels must exercise great care whilst proceeding past the vicinity of the works. Please ensure that the works are taken into consideration for passage planning and when navigating in this area.
