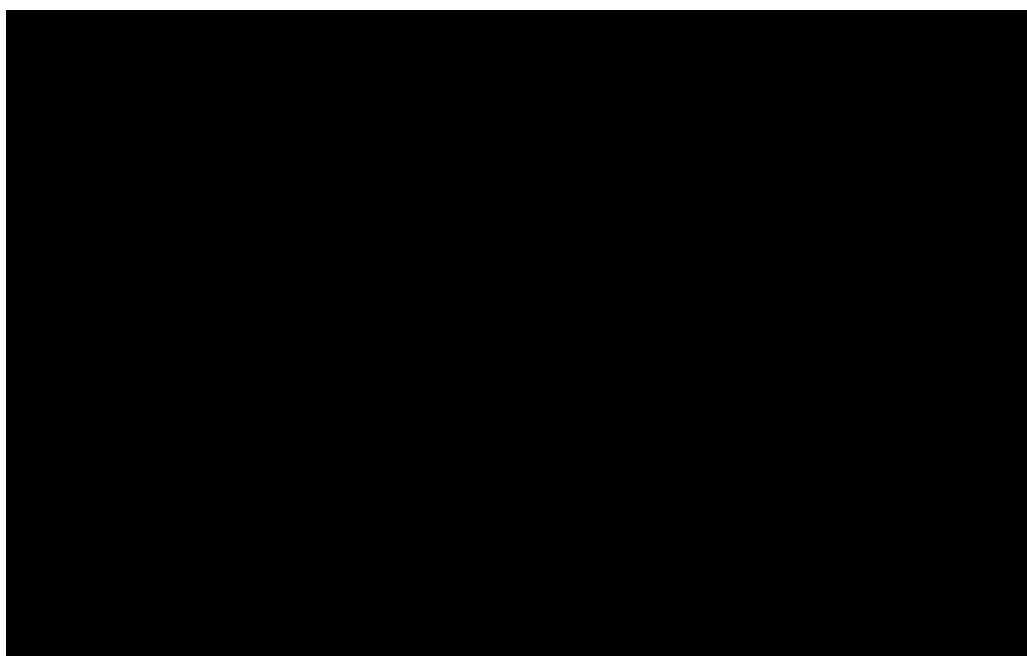

We are consulting again on the Regulation 19/publication version of the Local Plan.

We are consulting again some sections were not included with the Sustainability Appraisal. The Local Plan itself has not changed (other than to include an explanation of why we are consulting again and to include the new deadline for comments and these minor changes are in bright pink). If you provided comments on the first Regulation 19 consultation (that ended 26 September 2025), your comments are valid and logged and you do not need to submit those again. The Sustainability Appraisal has been amended; the changes are highlighted in yellow in the document.

Please note that these will be in the venues by the end of the first week in December as they are being printed and we wanted to start the consultation as soon as possible.
