

Appointment of Members to the Tolls Review Working Group

Summary:	This report seeks the recommendations of the Navigation Committee on the appointment of two of its members to serve on the Toll Review Working Group.
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1 Toll Review 2012

- 1.1 On 20 January 2012 the Authority adopted the scope, process and timetable for the 2012 Tolls Review. The process will include a workshop involving members of the Authority, the Navigation Committee and key stakeholders guided by an independent facilitator. This workshop has been scheduled for 21 June 2012. The workshop will be followed by two or three meetings of a Working Group with representatives of all the different key stakeholders and chaired by an independent person. The membership of the Working Group will be on the lines of the 2005 review and will include two members from the Broads Authority and two members from the Navigation Committee.
- 1.2 The Broads Authority appointed Dr Stephen Johnson and Mr Phil Durrant to the Tolls Working Group during the meeting of the Authority on 16 March 2012. The following organisations have also been invited to appoint a representative to the Working Group:
