

Navigation Closure & Restrictions due to dredging works at River Yare, Norwich

Update March 2025 - due to unavoidable delays in the programme, dredging on Bargate Broad channels will now continue until the end of April 2025. Dredging of the channels leading to Bargate Broad will be undertaken outside of the Easter period and during this time larger vessels may be restricted. Please follow the advice of the safety boat on station.

Notice is hereby given that the Broads Authority will be undertaking dredging works, from 17 June 2024 through to 31 March 2025, during the hours of 08:00 hours and 16:00 hours daily, excluding weekends.

The dredge site stretches along the channels of Rockland Broad (Grid References – start of the channel on Fleet Dyke TG339058 to the end of Rockland Short Dyke TG340052) and the channels of Bargate Broad (Grid References – start of the channel TG321078 to the end of the channel TG325073) (shown in red on the plan extract). The works vessels will be navigating the main river to travel between the dredge site and the offload site (shown in blue on the plan extract). The maintenance works on the water will involve the use of floating pontoons and small works vessels.
