

# Register of Interests form

Member: Nigel Brennan

As a member of the Broads Authority, these are the interests which you are required to register with the Authority by section 30 of the [Localism Act 2011](#).

**Register of interests must be declared:**

- **within 28 days of becoming a member; and**
- **within 28 days of becoming aware of any new interest, or of any change to a registered interest.**

**Failure to register or disclose a disclosable pecuniary interest is a criminal offence under the Localism Act 2011.**

Where you have a **'sensitive interest'** you must notify the Monitoring Officer with the reasons why you believe it is a sensitive interest. If the Monitoring Officer agrees, they will withhold the interest from the public register. A 'sensitive interest' is as an interest which, if disclosed, could lead to the member, or a person connected with the member, being subject to violence or intimidation.

**'Disclosable Pecuniary Interest'** means an interest of yourself or of your partner if you are aware of your partner's interest.

**'Partner'** means a spouse or civil partner, or a person with whom you are living as husband or wife, or a person with whom you are living as if you are civil partners.

This includes any payment or financial benefit from a trade union within the meaning of the Trade Union and Labour Relations (Consolidation) Act 1992.	n/a
<b>Contracts</b>	Any contract made between the member or his/her spouse or civil partner or the person with whom the member is living as if they were spouses/civil partners (or a firm in which such person is a partner, or an incorporated body of which such person is a director or a body that such person has a beneficial interest in the securities of) and the Authority (a) under which goods or services are to be provided or works are to be executed; and (b) which has not been fully discharged.	n/a
<b>Land and property</b>	Any beneficial interest in land which is within the area of the Authority.	n/a

<b>Licenses</b>	Any licence (alone or jointly with others) to occupy land in the area of the Authority for a month or longer.	n/a
<b>Corporate tenancies</b>	Any tenancy where (to the member's knowledge) (a) The landlord is the Authority; and (b) The tenant is a body that the member, or his/her partner is a partner of or a director of or has a beneficial interest in the securities of.	n/a
<b>Securities</b>	Any beneficial interest in securities of a body where (a) That body (to the member's knowledge) has a place of business or land in the area of the Authority; and (b) Either i. The total nominal value of the securities exceeds £25,000 or one hundredth of the total issued share capital of that body; or ii. If the share capital of that body is of more than one class, the total nominal value of the shares of any one class in which the member, or his/her partner have a beneficial interest	n/a
