Water Ski Zone Variation Consultation

Report by Head of Safety Management

Summary:

This report sets out a proposal to extend the trial of recreational wakeboarding including 'getting air' on the River Yare and to include the River Waveney. It also proposes the variation of times for River Yare water ski Zone 1.

Members views are sought on the variations set out in Appendix 1.

1 Background

- 1.1 At its meeting on 8 December 2011 the Navigation Committee considered a report which set out the findings and proposals of the Water Skiing Review Panel which was held on the 25 October 2011.
- 1.2 The Committee considered a number of proposals from the Water Ski Review including a proposal to vary the times available for water skiing on the River Yare and to extend the trial of wakeboarding including "getting air" to one zone on the River Waveney.

2 The Consultation

- 2.1 The Broads Authority Act 2009 includes provisions enabling the Authority to regulate waterskiing and wakeboarding. They include a power to designate, amend or revoke zones within the Authority's navigation area where these activities will be permitted.
- 2.2 At its meeting on 16 March 2012 the Authority will consider a proposal to pass a resolution that certain zones where days and times when these activities are currently permitted by virtue of the Authority's resolution on the 22 January 2010 and 17 September 2010 be amended to apply after 1 April 2012. These amended zones and times are set out in Appendix 1.
- 2.3 The effect of the proposed resolution will be to vary where and when waterskiing and wakeboarding may take place. The proposed variations are set out in Appendix 1. In addition from 1 April 2012 it is proposed that a trial be allowed for a period of one year for a form of wakeboarding including manoeuvres and momentarily leaving the surface of the water. The trial will be limited to six concurrent wake boarders in each of three zones, two zones on the River Yare numbered 3 and 5 and one zone on the River Waveney numbered 1 in Appendix 2.

- 2.4 Section 26(5)(a) of the 2009 Act requires the Authority, before it passes the proposed resolution, to consult:
 - such persons who own or occupy residential property, the amenity of which appears to the Authority likely to be affected by the proposed resolution;
 - (b) Natural England and such organisations as appear to the Authority to represent persons likely to be affected by it.
- 2.5 The Review Panel specifically requested that before any variations were agreed for the River Yare Zone 1, Postwick to Bramerton, that a consultation was completed which included the Rowing interests which were likely to be affected.
- 2.6 The consultation started on 25 January and closed on 22 February. Members' will be appraised of responses at the meeting.
- 2.7 The consultation was considered by the Boating Safety Management Group at its meeting on 2 February 2012 at which no comments were received.
- 2.8 The consultation was considered by the Broads Forum at its meeting on 9 February 2012 in which members were content with the proposals.

Zone 5 From a point 400 metres (437 yards) downstream of the confluence of Haddiscoe New Cut and the River Yare to a point 400 metres (437 yards) upstream of Upper Seven Mile House. No change to Zone

Zone 1 From a point 330 metres (361 yards)
downstream of the confluence of Oulton Dyke and
the River Waveney to a point 800 metres (875 yards)
upstream of Somerleyton Ferry Pier

b Between the 1st October and 20th March in any year: between 1300 hours and sunset on Sundays and between 0900 hours and sunset on any other day.


