### Message to the Authority from the Inspector – 8<sup>th</sup> April 2019

My report will shortly be available to the Authority for fact check. Please note that it does not refer to proposed change P7 in the Schedule of Modifications to Policies Maps (Jan 2019) relating to the amended open space boundaries in Hoveton and Wroxham. The proposed map change is not linked to a Main Modification and is not an issue that I have identified as being necessary for reasons of soundness. The proposed area contains some woodland and can partly be seen from public vantage points. However, much of the area has restricted visibility, does not form a key part of open land alongside the main river, and is in private ownership. I am satisfied that the boundaries as shown on the submitted Policies Map effectively capture the main public open spaces and key strategic tranches of open land alongside the river in Hoveton and Wroxham.
